Has over 14 years of Cabinet experience, and has served as Deputy Premier, Minister of Transportation and Infrastructure, Minister of Education, Minister Responsible for Early Learning and Literacy, Minister of Advanced Education, Minister of Health Services, and was the first woman to hold the position of Attorney General in British Columbia.

Mrs. Stephanie Killam: Served as Mayor of the District of Mackenzie for 9 years and served on Council for 9 years. Has served on the boards of the Regional District of Fraser-Fort George and the Northern Development Initiative Trust, chaired the Omineca Beetle Action Coalition and was a member of the Rural BC Steering Committee.
