CODE OF CONDUCT

In addition to providing a sound educational environment for intellectual pursuits, SUNY is concerned with developing socially responsible citizens, ensuring the welfare and freedom of all members of the SUNY community, and protecting individual rights. SUNY is thus concerned with the quality of student conduct and has adopted rules and behavioural standards for its students. Disciplinary action may be imposed when a student fails to recognize or violates the rights and freedoms of other individuals or behaves in a manner not consistent with program policies both on and off campus.

I. Standards of Conduct

The following forms of conduct are forbidden and are subject to disciplinary action as provided hereafter:

Primary Violations

1. Physical assault or attempted assault, upon the person of any student, employee, or officer of SUNY or anyone visiting or passing through the UNBC campus.
2. Utterance of threats by any means of communication, including but not limited to threats of physical abuse of any student, employee, officer of SUNY, or organization.
3. Theft or attempted theft of the property or services of the campus, its students, employees, officers or organizations or that of any individual or organization visiting or passing through the campus, by means of taking, deception including bad check, misappropriation or misuse.
4. Possession and/or consumption of alcoholic beverages and illegal drugs is strictly prohibited.
5. Weapons of any kind and items that could cause injury or damage to participants and/or property are strictly forbidden.
6. Destruction or vandalism of the real or personal property of the campus, its students, employees, officers or organizations or that of any individual or organization visiting or passing through the campus.
7. Disorderly or disruptive conduct which substantially threatens harms or interferes with program personnel or orderly program operations.
8. Commission of any act which results in the infliction of harm to any person or damage to campus property or the property of others by wilful and deliberate means or through negligence.

Penalties

Individual students found to have violated this Code shall be subject to restitution if appropriate and to the following range of penalties.

1. **Disciplinary Reprimand:** The student is informed in writing that his or her behaviour has been in violation of SUNY regulations. It is an assumption that repetition of the behaviour is not likely. However, it is to be understood that further misconduct may result in additional disciplinary action.
2. **Loss of Privileges:** The student is informed in writing that he or she has lost the privilege of participating in the program for a specific period of time. The student's parents, guardians or sponsors may also be informed in writing if it is felt appropriate.
3. **Expulsion:** The student is informed in writing that he or she has been expelled. The student's parents, guardians or sponsors will also be informed and asked to pick up the student.
