Prince George Campus Secondary Years (8-12)**

Applicants to the Secondary Years Stream must have:

- ✓ a four-year Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Science, or Bachelor of Commerce degree (120 credit hours) or the equivalent (i.e., a three-year Bachelor's degree with a teachable major plus 30 additional university credits) with a minimum of ninety (90) credit hours (30 at the senior level) in teachable fields relevant to the BC School system.
- ✓ Within the degree all applicants must have:
  - ✓ one teachable major or
  - ✓ two teachable minors
- ✓ minimum grade point average of "C+" on the most recent 60 credit hours of university transfer credits
- ✓ prior experience with learners of the age, grade and/or subject(s) they wish to teach

In addition to an acceptable bachelor's degree, the following courses *must* have been included within the first degree or must be completed prior to the teacher candidate being recommended for certification.

<p><b>2 English Courses</b></p> <p><b>NOTE: English courses must have an average grade of C+ or better.</b></p>	<p><b>Six (6) credit hours of acceptable English literature and composition at any level (one of the following):</b></p> <p><b>(a) three (3) credit hours of English literature and three (3) credit hours of English composition or</b></p> <p><b>(b) six (6) credit hours of acceptable English Literature</b></p>

**Note**

- A minimum admission average of 67% (2.33 based on a 4.33 point grading system) is required to apply.
- The admission average is calculated on the last 60 credits of university transfer course work.
