**Have a passion for nature and the outdoors? Enjoy connecting with the community? Experience variety and excitement in this healthy work environment. Learn new skills and earn competitive wages operating and maintaining a Regional Park.**

### **A PARK PATROLLER:**

- Patrols one or more regional parks on foot, by vehicle, by bicycle or by boat.
- Provides information and assists injured, disoriented or lost park users.
- Enforces park regulations and bylaws as required to gain compliance by the public.
- Checks broken, damaged or dangerous park facilities and repairs or reports.
- Observes any illegal activities and takes appropriate action.
- Works on garbage pick-up, litter clean up, equipment maintenance and operation work.

### **MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR PARK PATROLLERS:**

- Minimum Grade 12 graduation or equivalent.
- Ability to deal with the public in a courteous and effective manner.
- Good judgement in interpreting park bylaws.
- Good English language skills, both verbal and written.
- Valid unrestricted Class 5 BC Driver's License.
- Good physical condition and demonstrated ability to walk long distances.
- Available to work flexible days and hours, including weekends, evenings and holidays.

### **POSSIBLE TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES:**

Wildfire Suppression (S-100), Workplace Hazardous Materials Information System (WHMIS), Occupational First Aid (Level 1), Equipment Operations (such as small tractor, ride-mower, weed eater, chainsaw), All Terrain Vehicle / Utility Vehicle Operations, Safe Boating Operations, Radio Communications, Bear Awareness, Bylaw Enforcement, Incident Command System (ICS), Workplace Safety and more.
