Partnering for Sustainable Resource Management is a unique CURA project that focused on the relationship between a university and one First Nation with a goal to enhance the capacity of Tl'azt'en Nation to effectively engage in culturally and ecologically sustainable natural resource management, and to enhance the capacity of UNBC researchers and their students to effectively contribute to First Nation community needs through collaborative research. Four related research streams were designed to: 1) improve the existing co-management of the John Prince Research Forest through the development of local criteria and indicators of effective co-management processes and outcomes; 2) improve Tl'azt'en capacity to retain, record and transmit Traditional Ecological Knowledge; 3) explore innovative environmental education and training programs which incorporate TEK into science education curricula for both Tl'azt'en and UNBC students; and 4) Tl'azt'en visions for ecotourism initiatives, and explore community requirements for capacity building in this area. In addition to addressing the research objectives, the project focused on developing approaches and methods in collaborative research trying to change the way that universities have traditionally worked with First Nations. The project was a community-driven and bottom-up initiative: UNBC researchers communicated the existence of the CURA program to Tl'azt'en colleagues; Tl'azt'enne then raised and prioritized areas of research, essentially directing the original UNBC participants to find other UNBC faculty and graduate students in these areas. Tl'azt'enne participated fully as research stream leaders, research assistants, and research participants. The small scale and bottom-up nature has been both a strength and a challenge to the project. There were significant accomplishments in all four objectives resulting in a mix of academic (journal publications and academic presentations) and community-focused products (i.e., books, community presentations, capacity building trainings). As the project evolved an environmental monitoring component, an ancestral history component, and an archival component were added to the project. EDUCATION STREAM. SIGNIFICANCE TO CANADIANS.
