- Registered or immediately eligible for registration as a Registered Forest Technologist (RFT) or equivalent with the Association of British Columbia Forest Professionals (ABC FP). Successful applicants who do not meet the professional requirement may be considered at a lower level, subject to confirmation of eligibility for registration as a Trainee Forest Technologist or equivalent immediately upon employment with the Ministry. Applicants must contact ABC FP to confirm their eligibility.
- Must have and maintain a valid BC Driver's Class 5 License or be able to obtain within 30 days.
