



STUDENT TRAINING OPPORTUNITY

Job Title: Research Assistant

Responsible to: Dr. Kamala Nayar (KPU Office of Research and Scholarship)

Overview of the Role: To participate on a project engaging with ethnic minorities in Prince Rupert, under the guidance of Dr. Nayar.

Main Duties:

- To understand basic research, making use of standard research technique and methods
- To undertake basic research by preparing, setting up, conducting and recording focus groups with the guidance of Dr. Nayar
- To undertake—with the assistance of Dr. Nayar—the development of a questionnaire for focus groups
- To type all focus group notes
- Provide a summary of the key themes

Timeline: The student will have to meet with Dr. Nayar on 27 June 2013 to begin the initial work. Interviews are to be conducted between July 2md and July 15th. Project will have to be completed by August 31, 2013.

Remuneration: \$18/hour for approximately 100 hours

Qualifications: Enrollment in a university-credit program at either a college or university. Students enrolled in nursing, social work, social sciences or sciences are encouraged to apply.
