# **Application for Admission: September 2015 Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.)**

Before completing your application, please read the following carefully.

The Admissions and Standards Committee will consider complete applications only. The following information is required in your application package:

- Completed B.Ed Application for Admission form
- Official transcripts from ALL previous institutions
- Three (3) confidential Reference forms
- Your Personal Statement\*
- Experience with Children and Youth (resume format)\*\*

Applicants must provide a Personal Statement describing their reasons for becoming a teacher. This statement should NOT be longer than two (2) double-spaced typed pages (instructions on page 2).

The UNBC School of Education has initiated a program designed to promote access to individuals who are members of societal groups which have historically been under-represented in the teaching profession in BC. To achieve this objective, we encourage applicants who have confronted identifiable barriers to post-secondary education to apply under the Access Initiative. Applicants may identify themselves in their Personal Statement, to be considered under the Access Initiative.

\*\*All applicants are REQUIRED to have prior experience working with children and youth before applying to UNBC's Education program. This experience may have been gained through volunteer or paid work in schools (preferably in the age/grade you wish to teach), church organizations, coaching, past employment etc. Note: working with groups as opposed to individual children is recommended. Each applicant MUST follow a resume format for this section (details on page 2).

The School of Education is designed for full-time studies. With prior approval by the program's Chair, and subject to course availability, the undergraduate Education program MAY BE taken on a part-time basis; however, students may be required to enroll full-time during a portion of their program.

# **Criminal Records Check (CRC)**

(Please read "Note" on pg. 4.) Given the scope of the Criminal Records Review Act, as part of the admission process, UNBC requires a criminal records search to be completed for all applicants accepted into programs which involve working with children or other vulnerable persons. See the UNBC Undergraduate Calendar for further information.

## Application Fee (non-refundable):

- Canadian or Permanent Resident applicants: \$35.70
- International applicants: \$76.50

#### **Document Evaluation Fee (non-refundable):**

 This \$40.80 fee is in addition to the Application Fee. Applicants whose transcripts originate from a postsecondary institution outside British Columbia and/or any secondary school outside of Canada.

#### **Documents**

Provisional offers of admission may be made using unofficial transcripts/documents (this is not applicable to international students), and will be finalized when official documents are received. All documents submitted in support of an Application for Admission/Re-admission become the property of the University of Northern British Columbia, and will not be returned to the applicant or provided to other institutions.

### **English Language Proficiency**

Applicants whose first language is not English must submit evidence of English language proficiency prior to admission; acceptable evidence may be any one of: TOEFL, IELTS, LPI, or English 12. To be considered valid, these scores must be sent directly from the testing agency/institution to the UNBC Office of the Registrar.
