It is strongly advised that you plan your entry requirements early. UNBC's BEd program provides students course work and classroom experience over a 2 year period to prepare students to be qualified teachers. The B.Ed program operates on a cohort system wherein students are enrolled and function as a single unit throughout their program of studies and practicum experiences.

The program:

- Provides opportunities to observe a variety of classrooms at all grade levels;
- 2. Includes 19 weeks of classroom practicum experience spread over 4 semesters;
- Presents Methodology courses for all elementary subjects: Literacy, Math, Social Studies, Science, PE, Fine Arts & Second Language;
- 4. Includes courses in Aboriginal Education, Special Education and Counselling;
- 5. Leads to a Professional Teaching Certificate issued by the

Teacher Regulation Branch.
