### Minimum Requirement:

- ACT Senior Secondary Certificate: Minimum average grade of C.
- NSW Higher School Certificate: Minimum average grade of 3.
- Northern Territory Certificate of Education & Training: Minimum average grade of C.
- Queensland Senior Certificate: Minimum Average: Sound Achievement.
- South Australian Certificate of Education Stage 2: Minimum average grade of C.
- Tasmanian Certificate of Education Level 3: Minimum Average: Satisfactory Achievement.
- Victorian Certificate of Education Unit 4 Subjects: Minimum average grade of C.
- WACE Stage 3: Minimum Average grade of 50% C.
- AQF (Advanced) Diploma
