	One reference from a current or former supervisor(s) in a human service setting;
	One reference from a practicing social worker with whom you have worked, or are currently working; and
	One reference from an educator who has instructed you in an academic setting.
	Each of your referees will receive an email from UNBC which will include an online link to complete and submit your reference form to UNBC. Please note that relatives are NOT considered references. If you are unable to provide one of the required references, please choose an alternate reference and then email socialwork-admissions@unbc.ca to outline why you were not able to provide the required reference and why you chose the alternate referee to provide a reference for you.
	Upload Statement of Intent (typed, double-spaced, 3-page maximum)
	The Statement of Intent should outline your reason(s) for applying to a professional degree of social work as well as identify your professional/learning goals and any relevant vocational plans. Please refer to personal, volunteer, professional and/or employment experiences and what you have learned from these that has relevance for social work. Please ensure your name is at the top of each page of your document.
	Complete and Upload Human Service Experience Form

	Upload Proof of English Language Proficiency (optional)
