# **UNBC Undergraduate Admission Requirements:**

- Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC)/Intermediate Certificate: Minimum overall average grade of B (50%) or higher in English 12 plus three academic subjects and an elective for general entry.
- GCE Edexcel or Cambridge International Examinations: Minimum of two Advanced (A) level subjects and three Ordinary (O) level subjects must be completed with an overall grade point average of C or higher in order to be considered for admission. All A level subjects presented for admission must have a grade of at least C. Students may substitute two Advanced-Subsidiary (AS) level subjects for one A-level.

## Transfer Applicants:
