## **UNBC Undergraduate Admission Requirements:**

### **Minimum Requirement:**

- Bermuda School Diploma: Completion of S4 with minimum average grade of 2 (4-Point) in English, three academic subjects and an elective for general entry.
- GCE: a minimum of two Advanced (A) level subjects and three Ordinary (O) level subjects, must be completed with an overall grade point average of C (Diploma GPA 3 on Five-Point) or higher in order to be considered for admission. All A level subjects presented for admission must have a grade of at least C. Students may substitute two Advanced-Subsidiary (AS) level subjects for one A-level.

### **Transfer Applicants:**

- To be considered a transfer student, a minimum of 15 credit hours of acceptable university-level course work from a recognized post-secondary institution. Please ensure to provide your school's grade scale. Please see: <https://www.unbc.ca/registrar/transfer-credit-definitions>
