Minimum Requirement

 Pacific Secondary School Certificate (PSSC) plus University of the South Pacific or other post-secondary foundation program: Minimum USP Grade Point Average of 50% for general entry.

Transfer Applicants:

• To be considered a transfer student, a minimum of 15 credit hours of acceptable university-level course work from a recognized post-secondary institution. Please ensure to provide your school's grade scale.

We recommend that you also provide us with all of your secondary school results for prerequisite purposes

Official documents must be received prior to the start of semester.
