- Titulo Academico de Bachiller/ Diploma de Bachiller/Bachillerato General. Minimum overall average grade of 6 (60) or in English 12, three academic subjects and an elective.
- Bachillerato Tecnologico. Minimum overall average grade of 6 (60) or higher English 12, three academic subjects and an elective.
