## Minimum Requirement:

- From 2017: School Leaving Certificate Grade 12. Minimum average grade of 2.8 (B) or higher in English, three academic subjects and an elective for general entry.
- Prior to 2017: National Exam Board (aka HSEB) Grade 12 Certificate. Minimum average grade of 45\% (Second Division) or higher in English, three academic subjects and an elective for general entry.
- Until 2010 Proficiency Certificate from Tribhuvan University. Minimum average grade of 50\% (Second Division) or higher for general entry.
- CTEVT Proficiency Certificate. Minimum average grade of 2.8 or higher for general entry.
