- WAEC West African Examination Council. Minimum overall average grade D7 or higher in English, three academic courses and an elective. WASSCE (West African Senior Secondary Examination) English, three academic courses and an elective.
- NECO National Examination Council. Minimum overall average grade of D7 or higher in English, three
 academic courses and an elective.

For NECO results we require type, exam year, PIN number, and exam number.
