



# **UNBC Undergraduate Admission Requirements:**

# **Minimum Requirement:**

- Advanced General Certificate of Secondary Education or Certificat du Cycle Superieur de l'Enseignement Secondaire. Minimum of three principal passes in the National Examination with a Grade Point Average of C (Point Value 4) or higher plus a minimum of three subjects in the Ordinary Level National Examination with a Grade Point Average of C (Point Value 4) or higher for general entry.
- Technical Certificate of Secondary Education Level A2 or Diplome d'Etudes Secondaires Techniques A2/Professional Certificate of Secondary Education Level A2 or Diplome d'Etudes Secondaires Professionnelles A2 GPA of 60% or higher plus a minimum of three subjects in the Ordinary Level National Examination with a Grade Point Average of C (Point Value 4) or higher for general entry.

 To be considered a transfer student, a minimum of 15 credit hours of acceptable university-level course work from a recognized post-secondary institution.
