




Northwest BC Grizzly Bear Discovery Tour

Get up-close and personal with grizzly bears in their natural habitat for an experience of a lifetime in the remarkable wilderness of Northwest BC. Ghost Towns of Northwest BC

Escape to remote areas of Northwest BC where ghost towns of days past rest dormant among the region's scenic wilderness. Discover remarkable stories about derelict cemeteries and the remains of the "Boneyard" in Port Essington. Explore abandoned architectural marvels such as the dam and powerhouse of Anyox, and gain restricted access to the modern-day ghost town of Kitsault, for a rare night's stay at this ominous town site.

"The Town That Got Lost" – Anyox Exploration

Visit the abandoned Anyox Dam, Powerhouse and Cemetery, a deserted coke plant, steam plant, general store, red light district and more.

Port Essington Experience

Packed into a one-day tour, the Port Essington Experience offers memories to last a lifetime. Once a bustling cannery town and service centre for the Skeena Region, Port Essington is now just a ghost town of its former self. Uncover its 100-year history as you visit an overgrown cemetery, the eerie "Essington Boneyard," remnants of the fishing industry, remote hot springs, and an abandoned Icelandic fishing village.

Skeena River Historical Jet Boat Journey

Retrace the epic travels of sternwheelers that navigated the historic Skeena River from Hazelton to Port Essington in the early 1900's. Travel the 300-kilometre route through the coastal mountains by jet boat, taking in the awe-inspiring beauty and experiencing the history of the region told from the perspective of local experts before returning to Hazelton following the tracks of the Grand Trunk Pacific Railroad.

Upper Fraser River White Sturgeon Biology Experience

Join us for a two-day experiential biology tour on the Fraser River to participate in an active sturgeon research project and discover white sturgeon biology and conservation practices. Participants will have exclusive opportunity to catch and tag Upper Fraser white sturgeon under the guidance of fishery biologists and a local First Nations fisheries technician. This unique jet boat tour also includes a historical journey through the Grand Canyon of the Fraser River.
