    - Concerns: Potential the filtration system would imply tap water unsafe or undesirable to drink in its current form.
       Recommend students undertake research about UNBC community perception of drinking water quality on campus.

    - Concerns: Salaries very high compared to other proposals.
       Would need more information on salaries, as well as evidence of consultation with relevant stakeholder groups.

    - Concerns: Uncertainty regarding where website would be hosted, and what would happen once Serena leaves.
       Concern a website is not the appropriate venue for a food hub. Would like greater involvement from Office of Research.
