# Procedure:

Reducing Image Size with Gimp2

Go to Start>All Programs>Gimp2




Go to File>Open



Browse to the picture you want to edit



Once the picture is open, click on File>Export



The Export Window will open, reduce the quality of the image

\*\* Remember to give it another name \*\*



Your file size will now be smaller.




# Reducing Image Size with Paint

# Go to Start>All Programs>Accessories>Paint



# Click on File>Open




Browse to the image you want to resize

Once the image is open click on Resize



### Resize your image




# Save your image as a .jpg file

### Go to Start>All Programs>Irfanview




# Click on Open




Browse to the image you need to resize and click Open

### Click on Image>Resize/Resample
