8. **TEACHING**

(a) Areas of special interest and accomplishments

The majority of my teaching experience to date has been supervising fellows, residents and medical students in clinical settings. In this role, I have emphasized teaching around Head & Neck, breast, lung, and palliative oncology. In addition, I have a specific interest in survivorship care, and psychosocial oncology, which I teach at the bedside, and through short didactic lectures. I have also placed significant emphasis on teaching trainees appropriate examination for head and neck cancers, including endoscopy.

In addition, I have extensive experience supervising and mentoring students at multiple levels in their research endeavors. I have been the primary supervisor of over 20 trainees on their research projects during their undergraduate programs, medical school, residency, graduate training or fellowship. I also have didactic teaching experience in biostatistics and epidemiology, and have been invited by the Radiation Oncology Residency Program to lead a continuing lecture series on how to systematically evaluate research manuscripts. I have also give lectures to this group on (1) developing viable research ideas for residency, (2) choosing an appropriate supervisor, (3) basics of epidemiology, and (4) survival analysis. From this, I have received consistently positive feedback around my approach to teaching.

I have also completed UBC's ABC and DEF Education Primer for Clinicians. From these opportunities, I have been able to improve my teaching and mentorship skills. I am currently the Radiation Oncology Fellowship Program Director at the BCCA Centre for the North, and the Discipline Site Specific Leader for undergraduate medical students at UBC's Northern Medical Program. I have recently been appointed as the first Director of Faculty Development for UBC's Northern Medical Program. In this role, I am responsible for ensuring that all teaching faculty have high quality training in teaching medical and other undergraduate health care students, across all of northern BC.

9. SCHOLARLY AND PROFESSIONAL ACTIVITIES

(a) Areas of special interest and accomplishments

My most prominent research to date is focused on disparities in cancer care and outcomes between patients living in urban and rural areas, including a recent manuscript in the Canadian Journal of Public Health focused on breast cancer disparities. I have developed collaborations within British Columbia (BC) creating a multidisciplinary team of researchers with an interest in exploring disparities in access to oncology care, as well as cancer outcomes. I am particularly interested in exploring whether rural and socially disadvantaged groups (such as Aboriginal peoples) have equal access to prevention, screening, surgery, radiotherapy, chemotherapy, follow-up, and palliative care services.

The primary focus of my current research is on patient reported outcomes (PROs). I am the co-Principal Investigator, and Clinical Lead of a BCCA provincial project titled the Prospective Outcomes and Support Initiative (POSI) which has received over one million dollars in grant funding, and is focused on collecting PROs on all patients receiving radiotherapy with BC. This is a large collaboration between radiation oncologists, nurses, radiation therapists, and medical physicists, which I lead. It has the potential to be the largest population based collection of cancer PROs worldwide, and will enable real-world clinical trials that can answer pragmatic questions that are not possible to answer with standard clinical trials. To date, we have a > 93% accrual rate, excellent buy-in from front line staff, and the vision to expand this to all cancer patients going through the BCCA (i.e. including patients receiving surgery and chemotherapy).

I have also spent a significant amount of my research career focusing on side effects of cancer therapies including (1) investigating the accuracy of breast radiotherapy techniques developed to reduce side effects, (2) avoiding inadvertent radiotherapy exposure in pregnancy (3) exploring pediatric oncologists' views on discussing potential side effects with young cancer patients and their families, and (4) exploring cognitive side effects of cancer treatments. I have lead several research projects investigating a new cognitive screening test, the Montreal Cognitive Assessment (MoCA), in patients with brain tumours, which has been highly referenced. From this research, my research team has demonstrated that the MoCA is more sensitive in detecting cognitive impairment than the current standard cognitive screening test, the Mini Mental State Examination (MMSE). Furthermore, we demonstrated that the MoCA is better correlated with patients' health related quality of life and ability to integrate back into their community. For this work, I received the Canadian Association of Psychosocial Oncology's Award in Support of Psychosocial Excellence on two occasions, and the Canadian Association of Radiation Oncology's Jean Roy Memorial Award.

My ultimate goal is to improve the care of patients in BC, especially those living in rural and remote regions. I work clinically as a Radiation Oncologist in Prince George, BC, serving the widely dispersed, and sparsely population Northern Health Authority. In addition, I travel to Fort St. John, Dawson Creek, Smithers, Terrace, Prince Rupert, and Haida Gwaii, providing oncology consultations and radiation oncology follow up services.

Since starting with UBC's Northern Medical Program (NMP), I have developed research partnerships at the University of Northern BC, with community nurse caregivers in Prince George and Queen Charlotte City, with Communities Oncology Network clinic staff in Terrace, Vanderhoof, Dawson Creek, and Smithers, and nationally through the Canadian Centre for Applied Research in Cancer, the Canadian Association of Radiation Oncologists, and the Canadian Rural Health Research Network. I believe spending time in rural and remote communities delivering care and networking with community clinicians is an essential first step in developing a research career exploring cancer service to all of BC, including rural and remote communities. Through these and other collaborations, I have secured 21 research grants worth over \$2.4M since starting with the NMP, 11 of which are related to rural and remote cancer service delivery.
