Today, the company operates six pellet plants across BC, with a seventh under construction. The market delivery of nearly 1.5 million tonnes of annual capacity is supported by a Pinnacle owned port facility in Prince Rupert.

Operations are headquartered out of Prince George, B.C., with the finance group located in Richmond, B.C.

The Fibre Analyst is responsible for assisting the Director of Fibre & Trucking, and the Fibre Optimization Manager in evaluating the strategic, operational, and financial implications of fibre allocations and deliveries to all Pinnacle plants. These analyses will be used as a basis for the Senior Management team to facilitate decision making processes on new fibre deals, and options for existing fibre distribution as to maximize production while minimizing costs. Key metrics that will be analyzed and optimized include: delivered costs, moisture deliveries/removal, fibre mix and production.

This is a key position as success in this role will optimize the Company's ability to meet its targets while expanding its production capacity.
