

Choosing your Major Checklist

Students at UNBC are required to choose a Major when you complete 30 credit hours of course work. To declare a Major, or a Minor, complete the declaration form available online (<http://www.unbc.ca/registrar/forms>). A list of degrees available at UNBC is in the Academic Calendar: www.unbc.ca/programs.

It is common for students to change their mind about which Major(s)/Minor(s) they wish to complete. Students are able to change their Major as often as they wish and we are here to help.

Note: If you are changing your Major and have transfer credit it is a good idea to meet with your Student Advisor first. Often transfer credit is assessed based on the Major you have applied for. If you are changing your Major, your transfer credit will be reassessed.
