DEADLINE FOR **INITIAL** NOMINATIONS: MAY 15, 2019

Who can be nominated? Any UNBC faculty member, librarian or SLI who has undergraduate teaching as a regular part of their workload.

Who can nominate someone? Any faculty member, Chair, Dean, senior Administrator, community member, or **former** student.

What should the initial nomination include? The initial nomination should be submitted by the **nominator** in **electronic form** and should include the following:

- 1. a brief 2- to 3-page statement written by the nominator that outlines why the individual should be nominated;
- 2. a statement from the nominee agreeing to be nominated;
- 3. the nominee's teaching cv;
- 4. the nominee's teaching evaluations for the last 5 years (scans are acceptable).

The nominee may supply any relevant information to the nominator during this preliminary stage, but the nominator is responsible for the submission of the initial nomination to the committee.
