## Registration Instructions

### WILDLIFE DANGER TREE

#### Course Prerequisites- REQUIRED

- Three or more years of experience working in the area of forestry, resource management, parks management, wildland fire protection, arboriculture, or a related field
- Basic reading, writing and arithmetic skills (including the ability to calculate percentages)
- Ability to identify tree species native to BC

#### Fire Prerequisites (in addition to the above)

- Persons must demonstrate that they have recent fire-line experience (at least 10 days over the previous 2 years); OR that they have 5 days of documented danger tree assessment experience (forestry, parks or wildfire operations) in the previous calendar year
- Completion of the S100 Basic Fire Suppression course.

If you do not meet all three prerequisites, the University of Northern British Columbia reserves the right to withhold your certificate until a letter is received declaring that the prerequisites have been met.
