24-MONTH MASTER OF EDUCATION PROGRAM

Multidisciplinary Leadership

The UNBC School of Education is pleased to announce the 24-month Master of Education in Multidisciplinary Leadership program to begin in September 2018 (**December 15, 2017 deadline**). Students will take two courses per semester for six semesters which will culminate in the comprehensive examination route. This program is full-time and students would pay full-time tuition fees plus ancillary fees for each of the six semesters. Students can choose the thesis or project route but completion may not occur in 24 months.

The program also includes an exciting and unique opportunity in the offering of a course that involves a mentorship program with one of the local school district's or organization's senior administration for half of the course time. In this way, students will have a chance to acquire on-the-job training while the school districts and other organizations will have a chance to address succession planning.
