## Cultural Intelligence: Key to Global Security and Stability?

Cultural Intelligence (CQ), the ability to recognize the shared beliefs, values, attitudes and behaviours of a group of people and, importantly, to apply this knowledge toward a specific goal, is a critical component of military operations designed to enhance global security and stability in today's complex and volatile operating environment.
