

Inquiries by third party representatives

As it is not under our authority to do so, the Vice President Research and Graduate Programs and staff of the Office of Graduate Programs are not at liberty to respond to inquiries concerning accessing information in a student's file or the status of an application for:

- Admission;
- Exemption from the English Language Proficiency;
- Defence; and
- Scholarship or Award or Tuition Waiver

The exception is those that come from an applicant or a third party with prior authorization to act on the Applicant's/Student's behalf (indicated at time of application). It should be noted that discussions with third party representatives will be restricted to the process and procedures followed rather than an in- depth analysis for renegotiation of the decision or outcome.
