NEW BUSINESS:

- 3. Renewing the Campus Food Strategy Group (CFSG) K Gaudreau
 - A lot of work started up in recent years that require dedicated students to manage (e.g. Food recovery project, Fair Trade, Trick or Eat). Previously managed by CFSG. CFSG has had to submit Green Fund applications for support: inefficient means of funding. Would like to secure \$5,000 per year for CFSG.
 - M Dale Slippery slope of ongoing funding.
 - Z Holvick Provide some metrics of success for the program.

- D Claus Explore support from Ancillary Services
- Action Item K Gaudreau to put together proposal outlining previous success factors.

4. Proposal to ban bottled water – K Gaudreau

- Interest from students to ban sale of bottled water on campus (with some exceptions where necessary). Bottled water currently part of the UNBC Pouring Contract.
- The argument that water was better than pop.
- K Hewitt Ancillary Services would consider not vending bottled water in vending machines.
- D Claus Important to consider impacts on Pepsi Fund (which is reinvested into Athletics and other groups on campus).
- A Fredeen Need to acknowledge lack of water availability on Campus.
- D Claus Adding infrastructure after the fact very expensive.
- Z Holvick Consult with Conference and Events Services to determine impact on external renters.
- A Fredeen Recent scientific paper argues this will lead to increased purchase of soft drinks.
- Z Holvick Alumni Association concerned existing water stations taste bad.
- Z Holvick Be clear about goals we are trying to achieve. Is this the best way to meet those goals?
 - T Fuson Animal agriculture far higher concern for water usage than bottled water.
- M Dale Other institutions considering this. Develop a rational water use policy, which may include partial ban.
- Action Item Creation of working group to study issue: K Hewitt, R Snider, B Larisch, A Fredeen, A Cunningham

5. Bike lockers – K Gaudreau

- Have put together funding proposal to purchase 10 bike lockers at cost of \$20,000.
 Lockers to be rented out by NUGSS. Two options: (1) bring your own lock; (2) key rental.
- D Claus What is risk of thieves cutting open lockers? Current bike storage in Library not used.
- T Fuson Suggest starting with a pilot project to purchase 5 lockers and measure impacts.
