Move-In Packing List

Excited to move in and wondering what to pack? Here's a handy guide for what to bring and what not to bring to UNBC Residence!

Bedroom essentials • Bed linens (twin size) Blanket or duvet Pillow(s) and pillowcases Foam topper or mattress protector • Photos, posters or other bedroom decorations • Small fan (for use during warmer months) Alarm clock • Small personal garbage can · Laptop, tablet, and required chargers Backpack/tote bag Notebooks, binders, folders, pens & other stationary



- Personal toiletries: shampoo, soap, deodorant, toothbrush/toothpaste etc.
- Hairdryers, straighteners and other electronics that are CSA approved
- Shower curtain & shower mat
- Toilet paper
- Toilet brush
- Personal medications
- Small first aid kit (band-aids, pain relievers, cold medicine, etc.)
- Laundry basket or bag
- Liquid laundry detergent
- Dryer sheets
- Hangers

Kitchen & cooking appliances

- Pots and pans
- Dishes: plates, bowls, mugs, cups, etc.
- Cutlery and cooking utensils
 (knives, spatula, wooden spoon, etc.)
- Reusable containers with lids
- · Dish rack, dish soap and sponges
- Dish towels and cleaning clothes
- Garbage bags and a garbage bin with a covered lid
- Paper towels
- Small appliances that are CSA approved and do not have an open heat element, such as a microwave, electric kettle, coffee pot, toaster, rice cooker, etc. Plan with your roommates on who brings what!

Cleaning supplies

- All-purpose cleaner/disinfectant spray
- Paper towels or cleaning rags
- Broom and dustpan
- Mop and bucket
- Sponges and scrub brushes
- Glass cleaner for mirrors
- Garbage bags and garbage can
- Toilet brush
- Vacuums can be borrowed from the Housing Office or the RA on call

Miscellaneous items

- Essential documents: governmentissued photo ID (driver's license, passport, etc.)
- Immigration documents (for international students)
- UNBC student ID (if you already have it)
- Bank card / credit card / cash
- Prescriptions and medical information
- Contents or renter's insurance (highly recommended)
- Umbrella or raincoat
- Reusable water bottle
- Board games, cards or small hobbies
- Winter jackets, winter boots, gloves, thermal socks, scarves, mittens

What Not To Bring

- Hot plates, deep fryers, butane stoves or any cooking appliances with an open heat element
- Space heaters or ceramic heaters (you may use oil-filled radiator heaters if you need extra heat)
- Bidets, shower filters or any plumbing attachments
- · Candles, incense or any open flame item
- Firecrackers, fireworks, explosives, kerosene, or other flammable materials
- Electrical devices lacking CSA, cUL or cETL certification
- Extension cords, multi-plug adapters or power bars without surge protectors/circuit breakers
- Wireless printers
- Personal routers, modems or wireless extenders

What Not To Bring

- Unauthorized extra furniture (scroll to the bottom to see what furniture your suite already comes with) *
- Mattress (provided mattress cannot be removed) *
- Bed risers
- Any wall fixtures or decorations that use wall-damaging materials such as tape, nails, pushpins, screws, etc. Only painters tape & sticky tack are permitted
- Strip lights
- Real, replica, or fake firearms/weapons and other dangerous items
- Large volume alcohol containers (minikegs, kegs, bubbas)
- Funnels, beer pong tables and other high risk drinking paraphernalia
- Pipes, hookahs, bongs, rolling paper and other smoking paraphernalia

What Not To Bring

- Pets of any kind (accredited service animals may be permitted if resident has gone through the appropriate approval process with the Housing & Residence Life Office. We are not able to make accommodations for support animals at this time)
- Large fish tanks (only small fish tanks two gallons or less are allowed)
- Expensive or priceless items (jewelry, heirlooms, etc.)
- Real Christmas trees (prohibited due to fire regulations)
- Any illegal items under Canadian or BC law

Items Included In Your Suite

- Oven & stoye
- Large refrigerator
- Dining table and dining chairs
- Sofa and coffee table
- Bedframe & mattress
- Storage space
- · Large study table & chair with drawers
- Plunger
- Recycling bags

Note: Vacuums can be borrowed from the Housing Office during business hours (Mon-Fri, 9 AM to 4 PM) or by calling the RA on-call after hours
