

Palo Alto VPN Client Install for Macintosh

Step One

Uninstall current Cisco AnyConnect Client if you do not need it for other connections.

Step Two

Visit vpn2.unbc.ca. Login with your UNBC account credentials



Download the client






Open the GlobalProtect.pkg




Press Continue




Select GlobalProtect – and press continue




Press Install




Enter the password you have to install applications on your mac. (usually your account password)




You will see a successful installation notice. Press Close.




The installer will ask if you want to move it to the trash. Default – Move to Trash




You can change the notifications for the GlobalProtect Application based on your preferences. An example can be found below.




Press on the Globe Icon for the Global Protect VPN. Enter the portal address vpn2.unbc.ca and press connect
