

PACKING CHECKLIST

CARRY ON ITEMS

- Cell phone and charger
- Contact lenses, solution, carrying case - glasses (if needed)
- Sunglasses
- Laptop or tablet
- Change of clothes (in case baggage is delayed)
- Travelling toiletries kit (toothbrush, toothpaste, etc)
- Important medications



DOCUMENTS

- A valid passport and airline tickets
- Study Permit
- Electronic visa or Electronic Travel Authorization - To see if you require one, visit: <https://www.cic.gc.ca/>
- UNBC Letter of Acceptance
- Immunization and medical records
- Drivers licence (if you drive)
- Second piece of Identification
- Money, debit cards and/or credit cards
- Letters of reference
- A list of important phone numbers



CLOTHING

Temperatures in Prince George Range from -20°C in the winter months and 30°C in the summer months.



- Undergarments
- Socks (wool socks)
- Long sleeve and short sleeve shirts
- 2-3 pairs each of pants, jeans, shorts, skirts, tights
- Coats/Jackets
- Formal outfit
- Dress shoes, sneakers, sandals/flip flops
- Gloves/mittens, hats, scarfs
- Bedsheets, towels, pillows, pajamas

ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES

Electrical systems in Canada operate at 110 volts and 60 Hz. Appliances have a three-pin plug or a two-pin standard North American plug.

- An adaptor/converter for your existing electrical appliances (if necessary)
- Hair dryer



FOR CUSTOMS

- Make a list of all the goods you are bringing to Canada, including vehicles (U.S. students) with approximate monetary values
- If any of your electronic items have a serial number, be sure to record those numbers
- Do not bring any food into Canada
