Air Quality in Prince George

Air Quality is an issue of increasing public concern in Prince George and many interior BC valleys. This is due in part to the realization that inhalable fine particulate matter (PM2.5) is a significant human health concern with no lower threshold of health impact, and because ambient PM2.5 concentrations in interior valleys are among the highest in Canada. This presentation will overview past and ongoing studies being conducted at UNBC that aim to better understand exposure to fine particulate matter and the sources that are contributing to ambient levels.
