### **Natural Sciences and Engineering Grants**

BC Conservation Fund Stream 1, Intake 2 will fund inspired people and impactful projects that accelerate conservation for land and freshwater areas while creating wins for communities and economies.

Expression of Interest deadline (mandatory): July 4, 2025 Full application deadline (by invitation only): October 2025

NSERC Discovery Grants support ongoing programs of research with long-term goals rather than a single short-term project or collection of projects. Full application deadline: November 3, 2025

Genome BC Genomics Innovation Fund Intake 002 aims to support the development of transformative innovation genomics projects with commercial potential.

NSERC-ECCC Call for Proposals on Plastics Science and Innovation for a Cleaner and More Sustainable Future will fund research that advances the science around plastic designs and alternatives, the sustainable use of plastics, and plastic waste diversion and recovery.

NSERC Collaborative Research and Training Experience (CREATE) Program supports the training and mentoring of teams of highly qualified students and postdoctoral fellows from Canada and abroad through the development of innovative training programs. UNBC has a quota of one full application that can be submitted.

### **Social Sciences and Humanities Grants**

SSHRC Connection Grants support events and outreach activities geared toward short-term, targeted knowledge mobilization initiatives, which can often serve as a first step toward more comprehensive and longer-term projects.

Application deadline: August 1, 2025

SSHRC Policy Innovation Partnership Grants will support a partnership between an established postsecondary research entity (institute, centre, lab, hub, observatory, et c.) and one or more federal government departments.

Application deadline: September 10, 2025

- SSHRC Aid to Scholarly Journals offer a contribution to enable journals to defray the costs associated with publishing open access scholarly articles and digital journal dissemination. The mandate and subject matter of the journal must primarily be within the discipline(s) within SSHRC's mandate. Application deadline: September 10, 2025
- SSHRC Partnership Engage Grants provide short-term and timely support for partnered research activities that will inform decision-making at a single partner organization from the public, private or not-for-profit sector.

Application deadline: September 15, 2025

- SSHRC Destination Horizon Grants support researchers to build capacity, foster existing partnerships, and further develop networks and/or consortia with European Union and other "associated countries" researchers, with the ultimate goal of applying to Horizon Europe—Pillar II calls for proposals. Matching funding from the host institution is required and there is a quota for applications from each institution. Interested researchers should contact the Office of Research and Innovation well in advance of the application deadline. Application deadline: September 22, 2025
  - SSHRC Insight Grants provide stable support for long-term research initiatives in the social sciences and humanities, which enables scholars to address complex issues about individuals and societies, and to further our collective understanding. \*Note that due to the volume of expected applications, the internal deadline for Insight Grants is 10 business days before the SSHRC deadline.
