Natural Sciences and Engineering Grants

- NSERC Canada Postdoctoral Research Award (CPRA) provides support that allows postdoctoral researchers to add to their experience by engaging in research either in Canada or abroad and facilitates their transition to the next phase of their career. For applications to the NSERC CPRA, the subject matter of the proposed research must align with NSERC's mandate. Application deadline: October 17, 2025
- NSERC Research Tools and Instruments (RTI) Grants provide the primary avenue for university researchers in the natural sciences and engineering to obtain up to \$150,000 in sup port for research tools and instruments with a net cost between \$7,001 and \$250,000. *Note that due to the volume of expected applications, the internal deadline for RTI Grants is 10 business days before the NSERC deadline.

Application deadline: October 27, 2025

NSERC Discovery Grants support ongoing programs of research with long-term goals rather than a single short-term project or collection of projects. *Note that due to the volume of expected applications, the internal deadline for Discovery Grants is 10 business days before the NSERC deadline.

Full application deadline: November 3, 2025 *Note that a mandatory NOI was previously required

Fish & Wildlife Compensation Program (FWCP) is a partnership between BC Hydro, the Province of B.C., Fisheries and Oceans Canada, First Nations and public interest holders to conserve and enhance fish and wildlife in watersheds impacted by BC Hydro dams.

Full application deadline (all regions): November 3, 2025 *Note that a mandatory NOI was previously required for Columbia and Peace Region projects

Habitat Conversation Trust Foundation (HCTF) Fish and Wildlife Grant Intake supports projects that focus on native freshwater fish, wildlife, and their habitats; have the potential to achieve a significant conservation outcome; and align with HCTF's purposes as laid out in the Wildlife Act. Application deadline: November 7, 2025

Social Sciences and Humanities Grants

Stage 2 application deadline: October 29, 2025

- SSHRC Partnership Grants-Stage 2 are intended for large teams of postsecondary institutions and/or organizations of various types that work in formal collaboration and provide support for new and existing formal partnerships over four to seven years to advance research, research training and/or knowledge mobilization in the social sciences and humanities.
- SSHRC Connection Grants support events and outreach activities geared toward short-term, targeted knowledge mobilization initiatives that represent opportunities to exchange knowledge and to engage with participants on research issues of value to them. Application deadline: November 1, 2025

Note that a mandatory Stage 1 application was previously required.

- Indigenous Innovation and Leadership in Research Network Grants affirm and seek to build on Indigenous knowledge systems and Indigenous ontology, epistemology and methodology. Please note that non-Indigenous institutions may not be the primary applicant in this funding opportunity, but they may still participate on a proposal as a partner or have individuals participate on a project
- team in the role of co-applicant or collaborator, as applicable. Stage 1 application deadline: November 4, 2025 (deadline extended) Stage 2 application by invitation only

SSHRC Partnership Development Grants fund formal partnerships between postsecondary organizations and/or other organizations (public, private, or not-for-profit) of various types and are

intended to develop research and/or related activities in the social sciences and humanities; or design and test new partners hip approaches for research and/or related activities that can result in best

- Application deadline: November 17, 2025 SSHRC Knowledge Synthesis Grants—The Arts Transformed are not intended to support original research. Instead, they are intended to support the synthesis of existing research knowledge and identify knowledge gaps on The Arts Transformed, one of the 16 global future challenge areas identified by SSHRC's Imagining Canada's future initiative.
- SSHRC Partnership Engage Grants provide short-term and timely support for partnered research activities that will inform decision-making at a single partner organization from the public, private or not-for-profit sector

- Health Research BC Advancing the Use of Evidence in Seniors' Home and Community Care Program aims to improve home and community care for seniors through a blend of supporting both implementation of evidence-based interventions in seniors' home and community care and learning across health authorities, academic institutions, and communities. *Note that a mandatory LOI was previously required Full application deadline: October 8, 2025
- CIHR Operating Grant: Knowledge Synthesis Grants—Allied Health and Genetics will support projects aiming to enhance the delivery of genetic and genomic results in healthcare settings for the diagnosis and treatment of inherited diseases.

*Note that mandatory registration was previously required Full application deadline: October 8, 2025

CIHR Catalyst Grant: Canadian Longitudinal Study on Aging (CLSA) Data aims to catalyze and support research efforts of Canadian researchers to use the available CLSA data to better understand how biological, medical, psychological, social and/or economic aspects of people's lives have an impact on both maintaining health and the development of disease and disability as people age.

*Note that mandatory registration was previously required

- Banting Discovery Award provides grants that help early career health or biomedical researchers establish their independence and launch research programs. Internal Notice of Intent deadline: October 20, 2025
- <u>CIHR Catalyst Grant: Partnering for Impact</u> aims to foster the creation and strengthening of research partnerships that reinforce trust and mutual understanding between researchers, knowledge users (including people with lived and/or living experience, policy makers, decision makers, and health providers), Knowledge Holders, communities, and health and community organizations (including public health). Application deadline: October 23, 2025

Alzheimer Society Research Program (ASRP) provides grants and awards to support Canadian studies that promise new insights into causes, risk reduction, diagnosis, treatment and management

of Alzheimer's disease and other dementias. Application deadline: November 3, 2025

CIHR Operating Grant: ECRs in Human Development, Child and Youth Health aims to build research capacity, generate new knowledge, and support knowledge mobilization in human development, child and youth health by funding operating grants to early career researchers. Registration deadline (mandatory): November 18, 2025 Full application deadline: December 16, 2025

Genome BC—Data Access, Integration and Analysis Program (DAIA 2) supports the responsible and effective use of health and genomic data for research and innovation, in collaboration

with the Health Data Platform BC (HDPBC) by the BC Ministry of Health. Full application deadline (by invitation only): November 20, 2025 *Note that a mandatory Letter of Intent was previously required

CIHR Catalyst Grant: Digital Health will catalyze discovery in digital health, advance pivotal research, and inform applications or interventions relevant to CIHR-IMHA's broad mandate areas. This funding opportunity also seeks to benefit the continued integration of technology into healthcare in Canada. Registration deadline (mandatory): December 16, 2025 Full application deadline: March 17, 2026

- Health Research BC-Mitacs Industry-Based Opportunity supports graduate students and postdoctoral fellows across British Columbia to gain experience working within BC's life sciences sector. Full application deadline (by invitation only): January 31, 2026 Letter of Intent deadline (mandatory): December 31, 2025
- CIHR Team Grant: Strengthening Resilient and Equitable Public Health Systems (STEPS) aims to advance the field of public health systems and services research by supporting research that focuses on system-level solutions to improve public health systems performance (including the conditions for success). Full application deadline: January 14, 2026 *Note that mandatory registration was previously required


