Program Instructors will develop and deliver UNBC's summer pre-recruitment program called Active Minds. Active Minds offers high caliber explorative workshops and camps for kids ages 6 to 12 with a focus on STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math).

Responsibilities

- **Program Development:** Create engaging Active Minds programming for 2026, tailored to inspire curiosity and learning in young participants.
- **Program Delivery:** Facilitate in-person or virtual workshops, events, tutorials, and activity boxes, while maintaining a creative, fun, and safe camp atmosphere.
- **Camp Coordination:** Organize and lead weekly day camps during July and August, ensuring a supportive environment for all participants.
- **Outreach Activities:** Conduct outreach at local schools and community organizations to promote the Active Minds program and its offerings.

- Professional and mature attitude.
- Creative and innovative with strong communication skills.
